Street Art is Mart's way of life; indeed, he's been using for many years his skills and talent in his daily work, adapting Graffiti style to prestigious brands orders.

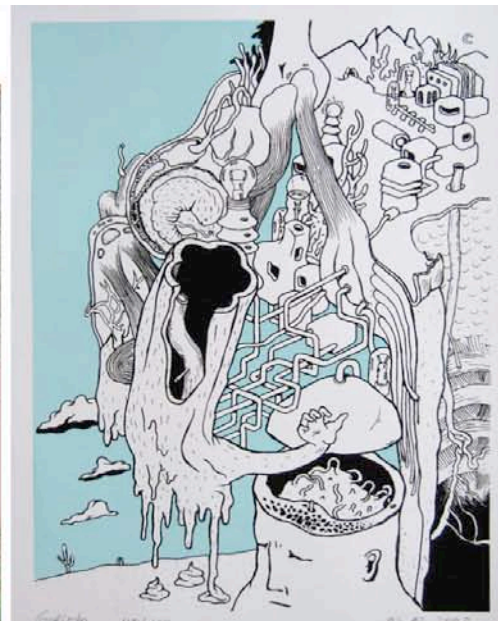
Today he enjoys seeing his arts canvas and walls in places he used to visit at school when his was a kid.
